COMMENT: 1. In accordance with NDP checklist this application contravenes EH1 as it will have a detrimental visual effect on the Angmering Conservation Area which it adjoins.

2.Road Traffic Safety. The use of flags and advertising boards could constitute a distraction to drivers on a very narrow lane that has shared use with pedestrians, vehicles and public transport. The proposed site is also immediately to the north blind corner.

3. Noise pollution. The siting of the flags may cause a noise disturbance to two residential properties, both within the Angmering Conservation Area. One directly across from the proposed site and a second alongside the site to the south
