16/4 **VILLAGE CHARITY ACCOUNTS**

CLERK'S FINANCIAL REPORT 16/6

The Clerk stated that the final accounts had been finalised and subjected to Internal Audit. The Internal Auditor's report had been received which showed no concerns. The Parish Council was due to ratify the accounts in the Annual Parish Council meeting on 18 May 2015.

The accounts show a precept received of £243,854 which, together with a supporting grant from Arun District Council of £17,399, amounted to the same basic precept as for the previous year of £261,253.

Other income amounted to £12,808, giving an overall resource of £274,061 for the year.

The outturn spend was £207,525 and, after net transfers to Earmarked Reserves of £52,139, the resultant General Reserve balance as at 31 March 2014 increased to £162,098.
