
Councillor Walk-in Surgery

Join us for a FREE session on how to give CPR and learn how to correctly use a defibrillator, plus some summer First Aid hints and tips.

Dial 999 as soon as you can, the operator will advise you where your nearest defibrillator is. If it is in a locked

box, they will give you the access code. When you switch on the defibrillator, it will tell you what to do and how to use it.
