- 1) A meeting was held 29th September to continue discussing the ongoing problems with the culverted pipe from the Herons Park Development to Arundel Road. The meeting was attended by the Drainage Engineers from County and District, our County Councillor, a member of the public and three Parish Councillors and the Parish Clerk. I can now confirm that I have had the chance to carry out both an Initial and Detailed Assessment, and these have passed successfully.

The next step will be for me to assess the Speed Data against our Speed Limit Policy, and then begin to design the scheme, before I present the proposal at a Traffic Regulation Order moderation, to a field of Traffic Engineering colleagues.
