The Chair added the following additional items:

There was to have been a special planning policy meeting on 2nd December regarding a major development on land west of Bersted, but this meeting was cancelled. This development consisted of Residential dwellings, Care Home, Employment premises, retail & community premises, and a three-form primary school. It would be interesting to know why this meeting was cancelled and if this application is still in force.

The Planning Policy meeting held on 28th November discussed the Brownfield Land Register (Part 1) which shows that there are no brownfield sites registered for Angmering.

Extract from the Planning Policy Minutes:- *“Disappointment was expressed that following the Infrastructure Investment Plan 2025/27 update the NHS had not provided any updates on progress with their projects, especially as there was money available to improve the health of residents. Both the Interim Head of Planning Policy and Group Head of Planning had discussed the lack of progress and would be seeking a meeting with Senior NHS Officers with the intention of progressing their projects. It was suggested that the NHS could be asked to attend a meeting of the Planning Policy Committee to provide details of their future delivery plans for health care provision in the district.”*

In view of the current situation regarding local health matters, APC are pleased to note this stance being taken by ADC and hoped that it would also address the current doctor availability situation within Angmering.

Conversion of agricultural building to flexible commercial use under Class R of GPDO. The floor area to be converted does not exceed 1,000 sq.m

DECISION: No Objection
COMMENT: See below
- 1. Application 02260 (Lee Farm)**
APC had previously made no objection to this change of use application provided consideration was made to the impact of the traffic generated by the change of use, together with the highways safety at the exit from Michelgrove Lane south onto the blind bend on the Long Furlong highway.
On re-viewing this application APC has concerns relating to plan 2451_PR-100_A, which reveals that there is an inadequacy of escape routes from the building, should the eastern end of the building entrance/exits be inaccessible. There appears to be no indication as to the type of construction nor materials used for the dividing wall between the two premises nor whether exit/evacuation can be gained from one to the other building via this dividing wall in the event of an emergency.
- 2. Application 02261 (Priorlease Farm).**
In principle APC does not object to the Change of Use for buildings A & B, however it has concerns regarding the lack of additional fire and emergency exits within building B. There appears to be no indication as to the type of construction nor material used for the separation wall between building B and the retained agriculture area which if robustly constructed could prevent emergency evacuation through to the agriculture area entrance/exit, unless one is built in. APC supports the comments by WSCC Highways and would also show concerns as to the impact of increased traffic generated onto the A27.

This is a village like Angmering that is both in and out of the National Park, for Angmering's benefit it would be interesting to know how this is dealt with by the NP and what to expect when Angmering's NP is progressed.

17 24/194 HIGHWAYS MATTERS

The Chair said that the Clerk had her meeting with the WSCC Highways Officer on 20th November 2024 and was able to update the list of work to be done. See attached list for the result and further actions which is enclosed with this meetings supporting papers. Cllr. Bicknell expressed his concerns regarding the waiting time at the parking spaces outside the shops and would like to see it reduced to 1 hour, this was discussed further and the committee clerk said that this would be included in the upcoming consultation. The Chair said that if there are any comments or additions to the list would Councillors discuss them with the Clerk for future inclusion in the list and discussion at committee.

TRO Consultation regarding 20mph has now closed – result in favour of the 20mph speed limit with recommendations to include the whole of Dappers Lane at a future date.

Footpaths: Councillor Bicknell raised concerns as to the state/inadequacy of the footpaths within the Parish. The Chair said that this needed to be discussed at a later committee meeting and maybe as a project for 2025.

3) Correspondence

Correspondence continues with West Sussex County Council regarding:-

- The ongoing activity/concerns regarding Dappers Lane i) the proposed 20mph for the entire lane and ii) the siting of the street lighting on the Lane outside Herons Park estate and the type of lighting used. WSCC has had the lights turned off whilst County considers the matter.
- It is hoped that the “Dappers Lane Survey/Consultation” may be published early in the new year.
- The ongoing issue of speed and safety of Arundel Road. It has been confirmed the northern part of the road will be reduced from 60mph to 30mph by Section 278 agreement with the developer. This work is yet to be completed.
